

Enrollment Criteria for 1st Grade for the 2024/2025 School Year

The Principal of **Sunny Canadian International School - Elementary School and Gymnasium, s.r.o.** announces **enrollment to 1st grade**, in accordance with the amended legal regulations, in particular with Act No. 561/2004 Coll., on pre-school, primary, secondary, higher vocational and other education (Education Act), as amended, and in accordance with § 3a of Decree No. 48/2005 Coll., on basic education and certain requirements for the fulfillment of compulsory school attendance, as amended; further in accordance with Act No. 500/2004 Coll., Administrative Code, as amended.

Enrollment to 1st grade - General information and criteria

- 13.4 - 14.4.2024 there will be a separate registration of children.
- You will receive the invitation from the admissions department.
- For the 2024/2025 school year, we are opening a maximum of 2 classes of the 1st year of elementary school.
- The maximum capacity of the first year is 40 pupils. The school reserves the right not to fill this capacity.
- The maximum number of students in a class is 20.
- The school decides on enrollment according to the following criteria:

A. Assessment of compliance with the key skills of RVP for preschool education, in the following scope and point evaluation:

Monitoring the level of school readiness:

Rated on a scale of:

- 0 - inconsistent with the concept of school readiness
- 1 - rather inconsistent with the concept of school readiness
- 2 - more in line with the concept of school readiness
- 3 - in accordance with the concept of school readiness

a. Level of mental abilities - up to 3 points

Czech language - up to 3 points

- communication skills in the Czech language
- general overview
- phonemic awareness (auditory perception, ability to distinguish sounds, ability to repeat what is heard)

1. English language - up to 3 points

Rated on a scale of:

- 0 - inconsistent with the concept of school readiness
- 1 - rather inconsistent with the concept of school readiness
- 2 - more in line with the concept of school readiness
- 3 - in accordance with the concept of school readiness

Level of English language in relation to bilingual education - Finding the potential of phonetic awareness for the English language (e.g. how the child hears letters and is able to repeat them)

Social interaction, mental resilience and physical agility

Concentration on activity - up to 1.5 points

Ability to follow set rules and self-regulation - up to 1.5 points

B. Strengthening sibling bonds - up to 1 point d

The system for assigning points for the given criterion (will be assigned administratively):

0 points = no sibling at ZŠ/G SCIS

1 point = 1 or more siblings at the ZŠ/G SCIS school

The maximum possible number is 13 points.

- In the event that the number of applicants is higher than we can accept due to capacity reasons, the school principal will determine the order of applicants based on the criteria under letters A and B.
 - A lottery will be held from the group of other registered applicants, which has the same characteristics and which at the same time exceeds the number of accepted applicants.
 - The chairman of the school board supervises the draw. The results of the draw will be published on the school's website. In the case of admission of twins, the twins are assigned one registration number according to the recommendation of the school ombudsman so that they are not separated.
1. **We will publish the registration results within 7 working days from the end of registration on the school's website under the applicant's assigned number.**
 2. Accepted children will be followed by the signing of an education contract on an individually agreed date by 23 April 2024 at the latest
 3. We will inform unsuccessful applicants in writing by delivering a Decision on non-acceptance, which will be sent no later than 23/04/2024
 4. Compulsory school attendance begins at the beginning of the school year that follows the day the child reaches the age of six, unless a deferment is granted. A child who reaches the age of six between September and the end of June of the relevant school year may be accepted for compulsory school attendance already in that school year, if he is physically and mentally mature enough and if his legal representative so requests. A condition for accepting a child born between September and the end of December to fulfill compulsory school attendance according to the second sentence is also a recommendation statement from a school counseling facility, a condition for accepting a child born between January and the end of June is a recommendation statement from a school counseling facility and a specialist doctor, who will attach a legal representative.
 5. During registration, the legal representatives will submit: their identity card, the child's birth certificate or, for foreigners, a permanent residence permit, or other documents (e.g. recommending an assessment by the relevant school counseling facility, information on special talents, medical fitness for education, health difficulties, etc.) .
